

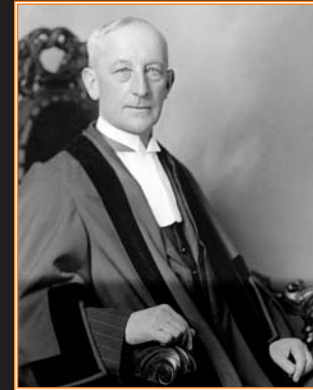


The Jersey and Guernsey Law Review is delighted to be publishing this facsimile edition of Charles Sydney Le Gros' *Traité du droit coutumier de l'île de Jersey*. The text has been cited in numerous judgments of the Royal Court and Court of Appeal of Jersey. In many instances it has been treated as the decisive authority. Indeed, as recently as the case of *Snell v Beadle* 2001 JLR 118, the Privy Council itself accepted Le Gros' discussion of the law relating to *déception d'outré moitié* as substantially accurate. The text forms an important part of the *doctrine* of Jersey law.

The Jersey and Guernsey Law Review has sought to add value to the text by including two additional parts. First, a compendium of end-notes has been prepared, providing a brief update on some areas of the law, and references to cases before the courts and articles in the Jersey Law Review where Le Gros has been cited. Secondly, shortly before this facsimile was sent to the printers, an index compiled by the late Oliver Mourant, *écrivain*, was found. It was thought that it would be of assistance to readers of the text, and this has also been included.
