**A LAW** to amend the Health and Safety at Work (Jersey) Law, 1989, sanctioned by Order of Her Majesty in Council of the

**1st day of November, 1989.**

**THE STATES**, subject to the sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, have adopted the following Law –

**ARTICLE 1**

The Health and Safety at Work (Jersey) Law, 1989,<sup>1</sup> (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Law”) shall be amended in paragraph (3) of Article 12 by deleting the words “Connétable or Centenier” and substituting the words “police officer”.

**ARTICLE 2**

The principal Law shall be amended by deleting sub-paragraph (d) of paragraph (1) of Article 21<sup>2</sup> and substituting the following –

“(d) to contravene any requirement imposed by or under Regulations made under Article 17 or 18 or intentionally to obstruct any person in the exercise of his powers under Article 18;”.

ARTICLE 3

This Law may be cited as the Health and Safety at Work (Amendment) (Jersey) Law, 1989.
