2. **The proposed curator must obtain a copy of the Mental Health (Jersey) Law 1969 and carefully read Article 43, relating to curatorships.** The proposed curator must also obtain a copy of the Mental Health (Jersey) Rules 1971. Both these booklets can be obtained from the States Bookshop, Morier House, St. Helier, or on line at www.jerseylegalinfo.je and both should be read prior to attending upon The Registrar of Probate.

3. Please attach a draft inventory of the interdict's assets to this checklist.
4. Please attach **two** written independent character references for the proposed curator.
5. Please also complete the self-declaration form as regards verification of identity and previous convictions.
6. The proposed curator must apply for a **Basic Disclosure** criminal record check and when the certificate is received send it to the Solicitor General at the Law Officers' Department. This can be obtained by applying to Disclosure Scotland (or other commercial providers). The cost is £25 and applications can be made on-line. You should receive your certificate within two weeks. If you are appointed curator the cost of the basic certificate is an expense properly recoverable from the proposed interdict's estate.
7. When you have completed this checklist, please return it together with the requested attachments to the Law Officers' Department, Morier House, St Helier, Jersey, JE1 1DD.

You should then make an appointment to see Mrs Jackie Woodworth, Registrar of Probate, Judicial Greffe, Royal Court House, Royal Square, St. Helier (telephone number 441300) so that she can satisfy herself that you will be capable of fulfilling the duties of curator. Please note that the Registrar may require an enhanced criminal record certificate to be obtained. The cost of this would also be an expense properly recoverable from the proposed interdict's estate.
