THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 2 of the <u>Dogs (Jersey) Law 1961</u>, have made the following Regulations –

1 Amount of duty

The duty paid on a licence issued under Article 4 of the <u>Dogs (Jersey) Law 1961</u> shall be £5.

2 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the Dogs (Licence Duty) (Jersey) Regulations 2004.
