For the purposes of Article 5(3)(b) of the <u>Social Security (Jersey) Law 1974</u>, the Class 1 minimum earnings threshold is £438.

This Order may be cited as the Social Security (Class 1 Minimum Earnings Threshold) (Jersey) Order 2021 and comes into force on 1st January 2022.
