REVENUE ADMINISTRATION (INFORMATION SHARING) (JERSEY) ORDER 2024

THE MINISTER FOR TREASURY AND RESOURCES, having consulted the Comptroller, makes this Order under Article 8A of the Revenue Administration (Jersey) Law 2019 –

Commencement [see endnotes]

1 Interpretation

In this Order -

"revenue information" means information obtained under or for the purposes of a Revenue Law;

"statistical information" means revenue information that does not include personal information that relates to and identifies a particular person, regardless of whether the person's identity is specified in the information or can be deduced from the information.

2 Revenue information that may be shared with public authorities

Revenue information may be shared with the public authority mentioned in column 1 of the table in Schedule 1 to the extent that it is necessary for the purposes set out in column 2.

3 Statistical information that may be shared with public authorities

Statistical information may be shared with the public authority mentioned in column 1 of the table in Schedule 2 to the extent that it is necessary for the purposes set out in column 2.

4 Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Revenue Administration (Information Sharing) (Jersey) Order 2024 and comes into force the day after it is made.

Office of the Financial Services Ombudsman	Submission to a Minister of recommendations for the introduction, amendment or replacement of legislation
Fiscal Policy Panel	Enabling or assisting the Fiscal Policy Panel to exercise functions under the <u>Public Finances</u> (<u>Jersey</u>) <u>Law 2019</u>
Income Forecasting Group established by the Minister for Treasury and Resources for the purposes of giving independent advice on forecasts of income from taxation and social security contributions	Enabling or assisting the Income Forecasting Group with the preparation of the general estimate of Jersey's public finances
