## COVID-19 (RESTRICTED MOVEMENT) (JERSEY) ORDER 2020

THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES, after consulting the Medical Officer of Health, makes this Order under Regulation 5 of the Covid-19 (Screening, Assessment and Isolation) (Jersey) Regulations 2020 –

Commencement [see endnotes]

#### 1 Declaration of start and end of restricted movement period<sup>1</sup>

A period of restricted movement –

- (a) starts at 8 a.m. on Monday 30th March 2020; and
- (b) ends at 8 a.m. on Monday 11th May 2020.

#### 2 Exceptions from requirement not to go to or remain in public place

- (1) The following descriptions of person are exceptions from the requirement not to go to or remain in a public place
  - (a) a police officer or authorised officer, when acting as such;
  - (b) any other person who is in a public place for the purpose of that person's work, when it is not reasonably possible for that person to work from the place where that person is living;
  - (c) any other person required to go to, or remain in, a public place to fulfil a legal obligation.
- (2) For the purpose of paragraph (1)(b)
  - (a) "work" includes work involved in the provision of voluntary or charitable services; and
  - (b) direct travel between the place where a person is living and that person's place of work is to be treated as being for the purpose of that person's work.

#### 3 Places treated as public

A private road or way to which the public has access, whether for payment or otherwise, is to be treated as a public place.

#### 4 Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Covid-19 (Restricted Movement) (Jersey) Order 2020 and comes into force at 8 a.m. on Monday 30th March 2020.
