THE SUPERIOR NUMBER OF THE ROYAL COURT, in pursuance of Article 29 of the <u>Magistrate's Court (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Jersey) Law 1949</u>, and of all other powers enabling it in this behalf, has made the following Rules –

1 Determination of costs

Where the Royal Court has made an order directing the costs of a person to whom an appeal aid certificate has been granted under Article 23 of the <u>Magistrate's Court</u> (<u>Miscellaneous Provisions</u>) (Jersey) Law 1949 (hereafter referred to as the "Law") to be paid out of the Annual Income of the States in accordance with the provisions of Article 23(5) of the Law, such costs shall be in such amount as shall be determined as soon as is practicable by the Judicial Greffier whose determination shall be final.
