## MOTOR TRAFFIC (CABS – FARES AND CHARGES) (JERSEY) ORDER 2017

THE MINISTER FOR INFRASTRUCTURE, in pursuance of Articles 38 and 46 of the [Motor Traffic \(Jersey\) Law 1935](#), orders as follows –

### 1 Interpretation

In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires –

“bank holiday” has the same meaning as in the [Public Holidays and Bank Holidays \(Jersey\) Law 1951](#);

“cab” means –

- (a) a private-hire cab, within the meaning of the [Motor Traffic \(Taxi-Cabs – General\) \(Jersey\) Order 2002](#); or
- (b) a taxi, within the meaning of that Order;

“public holiday” has the same meaning as in the [Public Holidays and Bank Holidays \(Jersey\) Law 1951](#).

### 2 Hire charge for cabs

The maximum hire charge for the hire of a cab shall be calculated and charged in accordance with the table of fares and charges set out in the table in the Schedule, unless –

- (a) a different hire charge is agreed by the customer, being the person who agrees to hire the cab, with the driver of the cab before the journey commences; or
- (b) the hire is booked through a third party (whether an individual or organization) other than the driver and the hire charge is calculated in accordance with charges which, before the cab is booked, have been –
  - (i) notified to the Minister, and
  - (ii) published by the third party in such a way that the charges have been reasonably brought to the attention of the public.

**3 Period of hire**

- (1) For the purpose of calculating the hire charge for the hire of a cab the period of hire shall be taken as starting when a passenger enters the cab unless the cab has been summoned to a place when it shall be taken as starting when it arrives at that place.
- (2) The period of hire ends when the hire charge is tendered.

**4 Citation**

This Order may be cited as the Motor Traffic (Cabs – Fares and Charges) (Jersey) Order 2017.

**TABLE OF CAB FARES AND CHARGES**

<b>Journey charges</b>	
<b>1. Hire starting after 7 a.m. but before 11 p.m. on any day except on a Sunday, public holiday or bank holiday (subject to 3 below)</b>	
<b>Distance fare –</b>	
For the first 176 yards or any shorter journey –	£3.01
For each additional 176 yards or part of any additional such distance –	22p
<b>Waiting charge –</b>	
For each 51 seconds, whether consecutive or not, during which the cab is stationary –	22p.
<b>2. Subject to 3 below, hire starting –</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• after 11 p.m. but before 7 a.m. on any day; or</li> <li>• after 7 a.m. but before 11 p.m. on a Sunday, public holiday or bank holiday</li> </ul>	
<b>Distance fare –</b>	
For the first 176 yards or any shorter journey –	£3.11
For each additional 176 yards or part of any additional such distance –	32p
<b>Waiting charge –</b>	
For each 45 seconds, whether consecutive or not, during which the cab is stationary –	32p.
<b>3. Hire starting –</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• after 7 p.m. on 24th December but before 7 a.m. on 27th December; or</li> <li>• after 7 p.m. on 31st December but before 7 a.m. on 2nd January</li> </ul>	
<b>Distance fare –</b>	
For the first 176 yards or any shorter journey –	£5.41
For each additional 176 yards or part of any additional such distance –	35p
<b>Waiting charge –</b>	
For each 28 seconds, whether consecutive or not, during which the cab is stationary –	35p.
<b>Additional charges</b>	
<b>1.</b> For each passenger in excess of 4 passengers being carried	£1.00
<b>2.</b> For every fare not paid in cash	50p.
