THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES makes this Order under Regulation 2(4) of the [Covid-19 \(Screening, Assessment and Isolation\) \(Jersey\) Regulations 2020](#) –

1 Authorised Officers

A person is to be treated as an authorised officer for the purpose of the [Covid-19 \(Screening, Assessment and Isolation\) \(Jersey\) Regulations 2020](#) if the person –

- (a) is a States' employee as defined in the [Employment of States of Jersey Employees \(Jersey\) Law 2005](#);
- (b) is employed under one of the following job titles –
 - (i) Covid Safe Officer,
 - (ii) Senior Covid Safe Officer,
 - (iii) Team Manager Covid Safe; and
- (c) carries an identification card, issued by the Minister, on which is displayed the person's name and photograph, and one of the job titles listed in subparagraph (b).

2 Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Covid-19 (Screening, Assessment and Isolation – Authorised Officers) (Jersey) Order 2021 and comes into force on the day after it is made.
