COVID-19 (SCREENING, ASSESSMENT AND ISOLATION – AUTHORISED OFFICERS) (JERSEY) ORDER 2021

THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES makes this Order under Regulation 2(4) of the <u>Covid-19 (Screening, Assessment and Isolation) (Jersey)</u> <u>Regulations 2020</u> –

Commencement [see endnotes]

1 Authorised Officers

A person is to be treated as an authorised officer for the purpose of the <u>Covid-19 (Screening,</u> <u>Assessment and Isolation) (Jersey) Regulations 2020</u> if the person –

- (a) is a States' employee as defined in the <u>Employment of States of Jersey</u> <u>Employees (Jersey) Law 2005;</u>
- (b) is employed under one of the following job titles
 - (i) Covid Safe Officer,
 - (ii) Senior Covid Safe Officer,
 - (iii) Team Manager Covid Safe; and
- (c) carries an identification card, issued by the Minister, on which is displayed the person's name and photograph, and one of the job titles listed in sub-paragraph (b).

2 Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Covid-19 (Screening, Assessment and Isolation – Authorised Officers) (Jersey) Order 2021 and comes into force on the day after it is made.
