## STATUTORY NUISANCES (JERSEY) REGULATIONS 2017

**THE STATES**, in pursuance of Article 3 of the <u>Statutory Nuisances (Jersey) Law 1999</u>, have made the following Regulations –

Commencement [see endnotes]

#### 1 Statutory nuisance of feeding wild animals, birds etc.

The feeding of any wild animal, bird, insect, reptile or fish in such a place or manner as to be prejudicial to health or a nuisance constitutes a statutory nuisance under Article 2(1)(m) of the Statutory Nuisances (Jersey) Law 1999.

#### 1A Statutory nuisance of gatherings of persons<sup>1</sup>

An event at which persons gather constitutes a statutory nuisance, under Article 2(1)(m) of the <u>Statutory Nuisances (Jersey) Law 1999</u>, if the event is of such size or duration, and is held in such circumstances in relation to potential contamination or infection with Covid-19, as to be prejudicial to health or a nuisance.

#### 2 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the Statutory Nuisances (Jersey) Regulations 2017 and shall come into force 7 days after they are made.
