**PARISH RATE (ADMINISTRATION) (AMENDMENT No. 3)
(JERSEY) LAW, 1975.**

A LAW to amend further the Parish Rate (Administration) (Jersey) Law, 1946, sanctioned by Order of Her Majesty in Council of the

23rd day of JULY, 1975.

(Registered on the 5th day of September, 1975).

STATES OF JERSEY.

The 4th day of June, 1974.

THE STATES, subject to the sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, have adopted the following Law –

ARTICLE 1

For Article 23 of the Parish Rate (Administration) (Jersey) Law, 1946,¹ as amended, there shall be substituted the following Article –

“ARTICLE 23

MEMBERSHIP OF PARISH ASSEMBLY

(1) Every person shall be a member of the parish assembly of the parish in which he resides if and so long as he is registered as an elector in that parish in accordance with the provisions of the Franchise (Jersey) Law, 1968, as amended.

(2) Every person, being of full age and having neither a curator nor an attorney without whom he may not transact in matters real or personal, shall be a member of the parish assembly of the parish in which he is a ratepayer if and so long as his liability to rate in that parish is not less than fifty quarters:

Provided that, in the case of persons jointly liable to rate, only that one of them whose name is first entered in the return made under Article 10 of this Law in relation to the land jointly held shall be eligible for membership of the parish assembly in respect of that land.

(3) In paragraph (2) of this Article "person" includes the representative of a body within the meaning of Article 22 of this Law, notified in accordance with the provisions of that Article."

ARTICLE 2

This Law may be cited as the Parish Rate (Administration) Amendment No. 3) (Jersey) Law, 1975.
