

Jersey Law 33/1986

SOCIAL SECURITY (AMENDMENT No. 6) (JERSEY) LAW, 1986.

A LAW to amend further the Social Security (Jersey) Law, 1974, to provide for widowed father's allowances, sanctioned by order of Her Majesty in Council of the

25th day of NOVEMBER, 1986.

(Registered on the 19th day of December, 1986.)

THE STATES, subject to the sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, have adopted the following Law –

ARTICLE 1

Article 12 of the Social Security (Jersey) Law, 1974,¹ as amended (hereinafter called the principal Law) is amended by inserting after paragraph (d) –

“(da) widowed father's allowance;”.

ARTICLE 2

Article 14(2) of the principal Law² is amended by inserting after “widow's benefit,” the words “widowed father's allowance”.

ARTICLE 3

The principal Law³ is amended by inserting the following new Article –

“ARTICLE 24A

WIDOWED FATHER’S ALLOWANCE

(1) Subject to the provisions of this Law, a widower shall be entitled to a widowed father’s allowance if the wife satisfied the relevant contribution conditions and if he has a family which includes a child who, or children one of whom, either was at the wife’s death a child of her family or is a son or daughter of theirs.

(2) The period for which a widowed father’s allowance is payable shall be any period during which he has a family as referred to in paragraph (1):

Provided that the allowance shall not be payable for any period after his death or remarriage or for any period during which he is cohabiting with a woman as her husband.

(3) In this Article the expression “the wife” in relation to a man who has been married more than once refers only to his last wife.”.

ARTICLE 4

The First Schedule to the principal Law⁴ is amended in Part I by inserting the following new item –

“6A Widowed father’s
allowance

Standard rate of
benefit.”.

ARTICLE 5

The Second Schedule to the principal Law⁵ is amended in paragraph 6 –

- (a) by inserting “, widowed father’s allowance” after “widow’s benefit”–
 - (i) in the heading;
 - (ii) in the first line of sub-paragraph (1);
- (b) by substituting for clause (a) of sub-paragraph (2) the following –

“(a) the expression ‘relevant person’ means, in the case of a widow’s benefit or widowed father’s allowance, the deceased husband or wife respectively, and, in the case of an old age pension, the person claiming the pension.”.

ARTICLE 6

This Law may be cited as the Social Security (Amendment No. 6) (Jersey) Law, 1986.
