## ANIMAL HEALTH (IMPORTATION OF PORK AND PORCINE PRODUCTS – AMENDMENT) (JERSEY) ORDER 2022

**THE MINISTER FOR THE ENVIRONMENT** makes this Order under Articles 7(1) and 32 of the [Animal Health \(Jersey\) Law 2016](#) –

### **1 Schedule to the [Animal Health \(Importation of Miscellaneous Goods and Animals\) \(Jersey\) Order 2017](#) amended**

In the table in the Schedule to the [Animal Health \(Importation of Miscellaneous Goods and Animals\) \(Jersey\) Order 2017](#), after prohibition 21 there is inserted –

“22	Porcine products, consisting in whole or in part, of a body of a pig or derived from a pig – (a) products of animal origin; (b) animal by-products; (c) derived products, which are products obtained from one or more treatments, transformations or steps in the processing of animal by-products.
