ROAD TRAFFIC (MOTOR CYCLE HELMETS) (AMENDMENT No. 2) (JERSEY) ORDER 2021

Made 4th October 2021
Coming into force 11th October 2021

THE MINISTER FOR INFRASTRUCTURE makes this Order under Articles 45 and 84 of the [Road Traffic \(Jersey\) Law 1956](#) –

1 Interpretation

This Order amends the [Road Traffic \(Motor Cycle Helmets\) \(Jersey\) Order 2004](#).

2 Article 1 (protective helmet to be worn) amended

In Article 1 at the beginning before “A person driving” there is inserted “Subject to Article 1A,”.

3 Article 1A (exemption) inserted

After Article 1 there is inserted –

“1A Exemption

The requirement under Article 1 to wear a protective helmet does not apply to a person who, being a follower of the Sikh religion, is wearing a turban.”.

4 Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Motor Cycle Helmets) (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Order 2021 and comes into force 7 days after it is made.
