THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES makes this Order under Article 2 of the [Long-Term Care \(Health and Social Services Charges\) \(Jersey\) Law 2014](#) after consulting with the Minister for Social Security –

In Article 2 (charges for long-term care services) of the [Long-Term Care Services \(Health and Social Services Charges\) \(Jersey\) Order 2014](#), for the table there is substituted –

4	Person requires long-term care services 24 hours a day, or, if not 24 hours a day, with a greater degree of specialist care required than that required for level 3.	£1,491.84	£213.12”.
