LONG-TERM CARE SERVICES (HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES CHARGES) (AMENDMENT No. 8) (JERSEY) ORDER 2020

Coming into force

1st January 2021

THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES makes this Order under Article 2 of the Long-Term Care (Health and Social Services Charges) (Jersey) Law 2014¹ after consulting with the Minister for Social Security –

1 Long-Term Care Services (Health and Social Services Charges) (Jersey) Order 2014 amended

In Article 2 (charges for long-term care services) of the Long-Term Care Services (Health and Social Services Charges) (Jersey) Order 2014², for the table there is substituted –

	level 3 or 4 does not apply.		
3	Person requires long-term care services throughout the day or night but such services are not required 24 hours a day.	£1,220.24	£174.32
4	Person requires long-term care services 24 hours a day, or, if not 24 hours a day, with a greater degree of specialist care required than that required for level 3.	£1,444.17	£206.31”.

This Order may be cited as the Long-Term Care Services (Health and Social Services Charges) (Amendment No. 8) (Jersey) Order 2020 and comes into force on 1st January 2021.
