MISUSE OF DRUGS (LICENCE FEES) (JERSEY) ORDER 2020

*Made**19th November 2020**Coming into force**26th November 2020*

THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES makes this Order under Articles 13, 26 and 27 of the Misuse of Drugs (Jersey) Law 1978¹ after consulting the Advisory Council on the Misuse of Drugs –

1 Interpretation

In this Order –

“2009 Order” means the Misuse of Drugs (General Provisions) (Jersey) Order 2009²;

“commercial import or export” means the import or export of a licensed drug in any circumstance other than personal import or export;

“industrial hemp” means a plant of the genus *Cannabis* with a tetrahydrocannabinol content not exceeding 0.2%, cultivated for the purpose of using only –

- (a) the mature stalk of any such plant;
- (b) fibre produced from mature stalk of any such plant; or
- (c) the seed of any such plant;

“Law” means the Misuse of Drugs (Jersey) Law 1978³;

“licensed drug” means a controlled drug or any preparation containing a controlled drug;

“personal import or export” means the import or export of a licensed drug for which the importer or exporter holds a prescription in the importer or exporter’s own name;

“supply” includes an offer to supply.

2 Licence fees

- (1) An applicant for a licence, or for the renewal of a licence, described in column 2 of the table in the Schedule must make provision for the payment of the application fee specified, opposite the relevant description, in column 3 of the table.

- (2) The Minister may waive the requirement for a fee under paragraph (1) at the Minister's discretion.

3 Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs (Licence Fees) (Jersey) Order 2020 and comes into force 7 days after it is made.

1	Licence to produce, supply and possess a licensed drug at a specified site <i>(Article 3(1)(a), (b), (c) and (d) of the 2009 Order)</i>	6500 per site
2	Licence, not being a licence under item 1, to supply and possess a licensed drug <i>(Article 3(1)(b), (c) and (d) of the 2009 Order)</i>	5000
3	Licence, not being a licence under item 1 or item 2, to possess a licensed drug <i>(Article 3(1)(d) of the 2009 Order)</i>	4000
4	Licence to cultivate industrial hemp <i>(Article 10 of the 2009 Order)</i>	1000
5	Licence to cultivate, produce, supply and possess cannabis (other than industrial hemp) at a specified site <i>(Article 10 of the 2009 Order)</i>	7500 per site, plus any fee levied by the UK Home Office
6	Licence for personal import or export of a licensed drug <i>(Article 4(2)(b) of the Law)</i>	25
7	Licence for commercial import or export of a licensed drug <i>(Article 4(2)(b) of the Law)</i>	100
8	Renewal of licence specified in item 1	3250 per site
9	Renewal of licence specified in item 2	2500
10	Renewal of licence specified in item 3	2000
11	Renewal of licence specified in item 4	1000
12	Renewal of licence specified in item 5	3750 per site
