Commencement [see endnotes]

1 Specified examinations and assessments for admission to the Bar

- (1) Each of the examinations and assessments to which this Rule applies is specified for the purposes of sub-paragraph (a)(i) of Article 3(2) of the Advocates and Solicitors (Jersey) Law 1997².
- (2) This Rule applies to
 - (a) the examinations and assessments included in any course validated by the Faculty of Advocates in Scotland for admission as a member of the Faculty of Advocates in Scotland;
 - (b) the examinations and assessments included in any course accredited by the Law Society of Scotland for admission to the Roll of Solicitors in Scotland; and
 - (c) the examinations and assessments leading to the award of a Certificate of Professional Legal Studies by the Institute of Professional Legal Studies of the Queen's University of Belfast or the equivalent for the time being recognized by
 - (i) the Executive Council of the Honorable Society of the Inn of Court of Northern Ireland, or
 - (ii) the Law Society of Northern Ireland.
